Description: (Max of 8 participants)	Students in this group may need more support with gaining an efficient pencil grasp and learning letter formations. Focuses on teaching printing concepts through movement & tactile activities using fun and innovative strategies with less emphasis on pencil/paper activities.	Provides children with varied sensory and motor activities in a playful and therapeutic atmosphere to enhance motor development and sensory exploration. Activities will target sensory play including tactile, pressure touch, vestibular, visual, oral & auditory. Children will participate in a variety of fine and gross motor games.	Students in this group may require a review of some letter formations but need more work with spacing between words and letter placement between two lines. They will have a good knowledge of letters and spell & read simple words. The group will use some paper & pencil tasks but more kinesthetic activities to enhance written output.
